

## BICYCLE PERMISSION

The following rules must apply:

1. Students capable of crossing the parking lot by themselves OR those accompanied by parents are permitted to ride their bikes to school.
2. Helmets must be worn by all students who ride bicycles on school property and on public roads.
3. Bicycles are brought to school at the owner's risk. The school cannot be responsible for damage or theft.
4. On arriving at school, all bicycles will go immediately to the racks and be parked. They will be taken home after dismissal. There will be no unnecessary riding around on the playground before, during, or after school. Bicycles will need to be walked on sidewalks during arrival and dismissal times.
5. Purposeful damage to another person's bicycle will be punishable.
6. Because of the dangerous crossing at Second Street, the alley behind Independence Terrace is out of bounds for walkers and bicycle riders.
7. Students riding bicycles without parental permission will have their bicycles confiscated to be picked up by parents after school.
8. These rules apply to bicycle riding to and from school only. However, riding in a fashion that provides a danger to persons on foot on school property will not be permitted at any time.
9. Bicycle privileges may be revoked by either the school or the parent for disobedience of rules.
10. Skateboards and roller blades are not permitted on school property at any time.
