

Conrad Weiser West School Rules

- Maintain quiet and polite behavior in the hallways, bathrooms, and cafeteria at all times.
- Hands and feet are in control; rough physical activities are prohibited.
- Foul language and name calling are not permitted.
- Students should respect all school property.
- Activities that create an unsafe environment for students or staff are prohibited.

BEHAVIOR PLAN

- 1) STUDENT ACTION IS OBSERVED BY A STAFF MEMBER, AND REPORTED TO OR RECORDED BY THE CLASSROOM TEACHER.
- 2) IF THE BEHAVIOR IS SEVERE OR RECURRENT, THE CLASSROOM TEACHER WILL CONTACT THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO REPORT THE BEHAVIOR AND OPEN COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE HOME AND SCHOOL.
- 3) IF THE BEHAVIOR PERSISTS, THE CLASSROOM TEACHER WILL SCHEDULE A PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCE TO DEVELOP AN INDIVIDUAL BEHAVIOR PLAN FOR THE STUDENT.
- 4) AN INDIVIDUAL BEHAVIOR PLAN WILL CONTAIN CONSEQUENCES FOR FUTURE OFFENSES TAILORED TO THE NEEDS OF THE STUDENT, AND BASED ON THE TYPE OF BEHAVIORS DISPLAYED.
- 5) THE ELEMENTARY PRINCIPAL MAY SUSPEND STUDENTS FROM THE SCHOOL OR THE SCHOOL BUS, AND UTILIZES THIS CONSEQUENCE IN CASES WHERE A STUDENT IS ENDANGERING OTHER STUDENTS OR CREATING AN UNSAFE SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT.
